(PRESSES ON) I was deeply in love with your mother and when I lost her, I couldn't handle it. I trashed my life. You got hurt in the process.

DUSTIN

Look, I appreciate that you're trying to help now, but you can stop. You're making the situation sound so simple when it's not. A lot of things happened in my life while you were gone. To think that I might do the things you did or make the same mistakes... trust me when I say it's not going to happen. I'm not you. I'm not a drunk and I enjoy playing the field.

CHARLES

But you are like me when I was
younger, before I met your mom! I
didn't want to get tied down. I
eventually learned there was no
