EXT. CABIN FRONT PORCH - DAY

CARRIE

Hi.

BRODY

I didn't drink tea at Langley. Yorkshire Gold. That wasn't just a lucky guess:

CARRIE

Why does that matter?

BRODY

Were you watching me?

CARRIE

I don't know what you mean.

BRODY

I mean did you spy on me. You are a spy, right?

CARRIE

Brody -

BRODY

That's why we ran into each at the support group, isn't it? Why you slipped me your number in case I ever needed to ask anything?

CARRIE

No, you're wrong, Brody.

BRODY

Don't fucking lie to me, Carrie!

CARRIE

It was my job. It is my job.

BRODY

So you're still spying on me.

CARRIE

I'm working! I'm always working!

BRODY

On what suspicion? Tell me, damn it!

She runs for the door but he blocks her way. He produces her pistol.

BRODY

You looking for this?

CARRIE

Abu Nazir's bomb maker told me an American prisoner of war had been turned. He was coming home to carry out an attack.

BRODY

And you believed this?

CARRIE

He told me minutes before he was executed.

BRODY

So?

CARRIE

So, he was my prisoner. I interrogated him for months. He was cooperating at the end. There was no reason for him to lie.

BRODY

You think I'm that POW?

CARRIE

There's no one else it could be.

BRODY

You're telling me the fucking CIA thinks I'm working for Al Qaeda!

There is a long moment.

CARRIE

I think you're working for Al
Qaeda.

BRODY

What about the gun, Carrie? Bears? Intruders?

CARRIE

We just keep it in the cabin.

BRODY

Mhm. Plus, you never know when a terrorist might darken your door.

CARRIE

I didn't say terrorist, I said turned.

BRODY

If that were true, if any of this were true, wouldn't I just kill you right now?

CARRIE

Not if you're playing the long game.

BRODY puts the gun down on the table and sits.

BRODY

Ask me anything.

CARRIE

What?

BRODY

There's the gun. Hold it to my fucking head and ask me anything you want to know. I'll show you how wrong you are.

After a moment, she sits.

CARRIE

Alfsel Hamid.

BRODY

What about him?

CARRIE

Did you slip him the razor blade in the safe house?

BRODY

How could I do that?

CARRIE

Answer the question!

BRODY

No. But I wish I had. And I hope he bled slowly and died in a lot of pain.

CARRIE

Who's Isa?

BRODY

Where'd you hear that name?

CARRIE

Who is he?

BRODY

He was my guard. He was nice to me.

CARRIE

What goes on in your garage?

BRODY

In my garage?

CARRIE

You said ask anything.

BRODY

I take the trash bins in and out. Fix a bicycle sometimes.

CARRIE

Why do you go there so late at night, so early in the morning?

BRODY

To pray.

BRODY systematically taps his fingers together.

CARRIE

What is that?

BRODY

Nothing.

CARRIE

No, it's not nothing.

BRODY

It's a habit. When I don't have my prayer beads.

CARRIE

You're a Muslim?

BRODY

Yeah. You live in despair for eight years and you might turn to religion too. And the King James Bible was not available.

CARRIE

Why did they kill Walker and not you?

BRODY

You asked me that at the debrief.

CARRIE

Yeah, and you were evasive.

BRODY

It doesn't matter.

CARRIE

I'll decide that.

BRODY

You don't need to know.

CARRIE

I need to know everything.

A long moment.

BRODY

I killed him. OK? I killed him. They told me to beat him to death or be killed myself. So I did it. And I vowed to never tell another living soul.

CARRIE

Who told you to kill him?

BRODY

Abu Nazir.

CARRIE

So you did meet him?

BRODY

Yes.

CARRIE

You lied to us about meeting one of the leaders of Al Qaeada?

BRODY

That's right.

CARRIE

You want to explain that?

BRODY

I was embarrassed. Ashamed.

CARRIE

Why?

BRODY

Because he offered me comfort and I took it.

CARRIE

And you became his follower? A soldier in his jihad?

BRODY

No. No. Don't you understand anything I'm telling you? I'm not made of that stuff. I'm no hero. I had nothing to give. I was broken, living in the dark for years. And a man walked in and he was kind to me. And I loved him. So are we done here?

CARRIE

Well, you have an answer for everything.

BRODY

But you still don't believe me.

CARRIE

I know an American POW was turned. It has to be you.

BRODY

I'm leaving.

CARRIE

We're not finished.

BRODY

Yeah, we're finished. If you want to arrest me you can come to my house.

He stands.

CARRIE

Brody!

BRODY Or maybe you want to shoot me now.

He turns and walks away.
